## DEFINITIONS

Stars	BauerFinancial Inc.'s proprietary rating. (Please see below.)
Total Assets	The size of the institution.
Profit (Loss)	The dollar amount of net income (or loss if a negative number) for the period noted.
Return on Assets & Return on Equity	Ratios regarding profitability – higher ratios indicate higher net income. (Calculation = Annualized year-to-date profit or loss as a percent of average assets or equity.)
Leverage Capital Ratio	The ratio of capital to assets (or "cushion"). Banks must maintain a ratio of at least 5% to be considered "well-capitalized" by the FDIC. As a rule, the higher the ratio is the better.
Nonperforming Assets	Loans past due 90 days or more + nonaccrual loans + other real estate owned (generally acquired via repossession).

## STAR RATINGS

BauerFinancial star ratings classify each institution based upon a complex formula factoring in current and historical data. The first level of evaluation is the capital level of the institution followed by other relevant data including, but not limited, to: profitability, historical trends, loan delinquencies, repossessed assets, reserves, regulatory compliance, proposed regulations and asset quality. Negative trends are projected forward to compensate for the lag time in the data. BauerFinancial employs conservative measures when assigning these ratings and consequently our analysis may be lower than those supplied by other analysts or the institutions themselves. 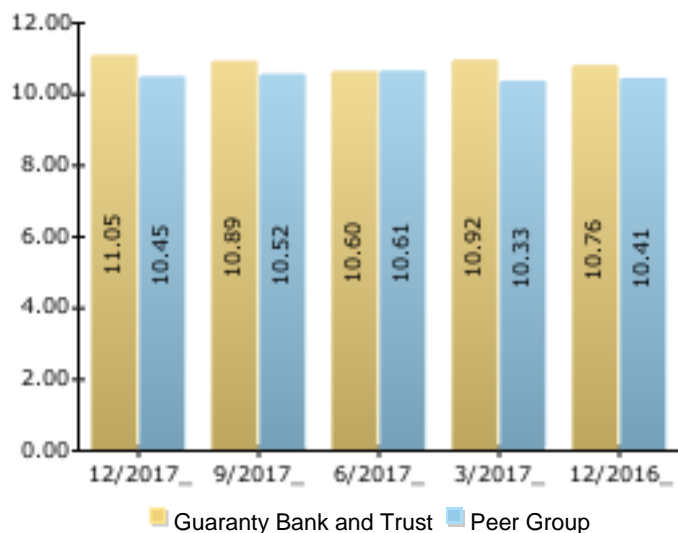

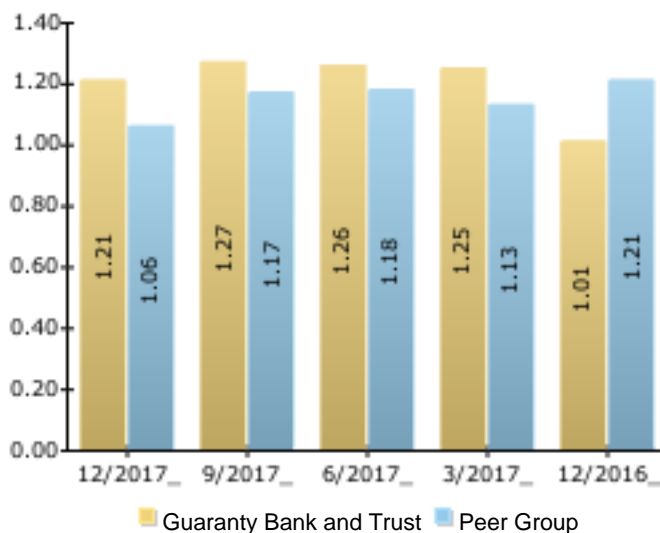
**Leverage Capital Ratio (%)**
